Section 21 of the Firearms Act:

It is an offence for any person who is prohibited by section 21 of the firearms act 1968 (as amended) to have in their possession at any time firearms and ammunition.

It is an offence for any person to transfer, let or hire, give or lend, any firearm or ammunition to another known to be, or having reasonable suspicion of being, a prohibited person under the conditions of section 21.

Section 21 applies to any person who has been sentenced to imprisonment or youth custody or detention in a Young Offender's Institution for three months or more.

The period for which they are prohibited depends on their length of sentence.

If the sentence was LONGER THAN THREE YEARS, the prohibition is for life.

If the sentence was for THREE MONTHS OR MORE, but LESS THAN THREE YEARS, the prohibition lasts for FIVE YEARS from the date of release.

Applicants NOT holding a Firearms Certificate.

If you do not have a Firearms Certificate, an initial evenings tuition with one of the clubs coaches/instructors will be arranged.

If you wish to bring your form to the club and receive an initial evenings' tuition and shoot, 48 hours notice must be given so the documentation can be processed and a coach/instructor can be present.

You will only be able to shoot if an appointment has been made.
